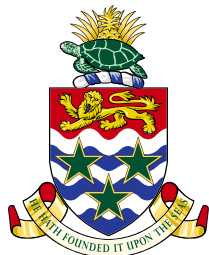

TRANSPORT) REGULATIONS, 2015****(SL 28 of 2015)**

The Cabinet, in exercise of the power conferred by section 37 of the Endangered Species (Trade and Transport) Law, 2004, makes the following Regulations —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Endangered Species (Trade and Transport) Regulations, 2015.

Application form for permit or certificate

2. (1) A person who wishes to import, export, re-export, trade in or facilitate the transit or transshipment of any specimen of a species identified in section 6(1) of the Law and for which a permit or a certificate is required, shall, pursuant to section 7 of the Law, submit an application to the Management Authority.
(2) An application for a permit or a certificate referred to in paragraph (1) shall be made in the form set out in Schedule 1.

Form of permit or certificate

3. A permit or certificate granted pursuant to an application made under regulation 2 shall be in the form set out in Schedule 2.

Designated ports of entry and exit

4. (1) For purposes of the entry into or exit from the Islands of any specimen of a species identified in section 6(1) of the Law, the ports of entry or exit shall be those designated in Schedule 3.
- (2) A designated port of entry or exit shall be determined based on the method used to facilitate the entry into or exit from the Islands of any specimen of a species.
- (3) The relevant customs officer in charge shall be the person who has responsibility for the management and control of a designated port of entry and exit.
