**PATENTS AND TRADE MARKS
(TRANSITIONAL PROVISION)
REGULATIONS, 2012**

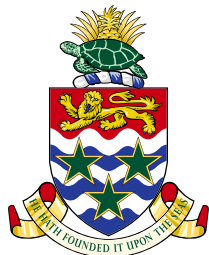

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In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 23(5) and (6) of the Patents and Trade Marks Law, 2011 the Governor in Cabinet makes the following Regulations —

Citation and commencement

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Patents and Trade Marks (Transitional Provision) Regulations, 2012.
- (2) These Regulations are deemed to have come into force on 7th December, 2011.

Transitional provision

2. (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Law, the owner of a patent or trade mark or his agent may transact business with the Registry without a registered agent during the period commencing on the date of commencement of these Regulations and ending on 31st March, 2012.
- (2) For the purposes of these Regulations “transact business” includes making an application or a request, giving notification and paying fees under the Law.
