**A LAW TO AMEND THE PRISONS LAW; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND
CONNECTED PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

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| 1. This Law may be cited as the Prisons (Amendment) Law, 1998. | Short title |
