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THE STATISTICS LAW (1996 REVISION)
THE CENSUS (CAYMAN ISLANDS) ORDER, 1999

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In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 4 of the Statistics Law (1996 Revision) the following Order is hereby made -

1. This Order may be cited as the Census (Cayman Islands) Order, 1999.

Citation

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires-

Interpretation

“census day” means the 10th October, 1999;

“census night” means the period from 9:00 p.m. on census day to 6:00a.m. on the following day, or part of such period;

“resident” means a person who has lived in the Cayman Islands for at least six consecutive months; and includes those persons in the Islands on census night who intend to remain in the Cayman Islands for at least six months; and

“visitor” means any person who is not a resident.

3. A census shall be taken of the population of the Cayman Islands on census day.

Requirement to take census.

4. Returns for the purposes of the census shall be made with respect to all persons who are alive at midnight on census night, and -

Persons to be included in census

- (a) who, being residents or visitors, pass census night on land within the Cayman Islands;
- (b) who, being resident, are absent from the Cayman Islands on census night with the intention to return not later than six months after the date of leaving; or
- (c) who pass census night on a ship or boat within the territorial waters of the Cayman Islands.

5. Returns shall be made by persons specified in regulation 10 of the Census (Cayman Islands) Regulations, 1999.

Persons by whom returns are to be made

Particulars to be
included in returns.

6. The particulars to be stated in the returns in respect of every person to whom this Order applies shall be those specified in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Particulars to be included in Census Return

1. (1) In respect of each person completing the return, whether resident or visitor -
 - (a) name;
 - (b) gender; and
 - (c) usual address, and address on census day, if different.
- (2) In respect of each resident -
 - (a) date of birth;
 - (b) relationship in household;
 - (c) marital status;
 - (d) union status;
 - (e) country of birth;
 - (f) citizenship;
 - (g) residence one year ago;
 - (h) country of previous residence, if any;
 - (i) year of arrival in the Cayman Islands;
 - (j) disability;
 - (k) type of disability;
 - (l) limitation of activities;
 - (m) areas of limitations;
 - (n) health insurance coverage;
 - (o) language(s) spoken;
 - (p) language(s) most often spoken at home;
 - (q) religion;
 - (r) present education;
 - (s) type of school or institution attending;
 - (t) school location;
 - (u) mode of travelling to school; and
 - (v) highest qualification achieved.
- (3) In respect of persons 15 years of age and over-
 - (a) details of any training received;
 - (b) qualification received;

- (c) unpaid household activities during week of October 3 to October 9, 1999;
 - (d) main employment activity for week commencing October 3 to October 9, 1999;
 - (e) whether or not a second job is held;
 - (f) business of employer;
 - (g) occupation;
 - (h) district in which main employment is located;
 - (i) weekly hours worked;
 - (j) method of daily transport to work;
 - (k) income from paid employment for the calendar year 1998;
 - (l) income from self employment for the calendar year 1998;
 - (m) income from Government for the calendar year 1998;
 - (n) income from friends and family abroad for the calendar year 1998;
 - (o) income from other sources for the calendar year 1998;
 - (p) contribution to a pension plan; and
 - (q) income sent abroad during the calendar year 1998.
- (4) In respect of every resident female aged 15 years and over -
- (a) total number of live births; and
 - (b) total number of live births in the last twelve months.
- (5) In respect of each person, resident or visitor, who is completing the census return, the following particulars of the dwelling or living quarters of the household -
- (a) year of construction;
 - (b) material of outer walls;
 - (c) roof material;
 - (d) type of dwelling;
 - (e) water sources;
 - (f) type of water supply;
 - (g) type of sewage supply;
 - (h) energy for lighting;
 - (i) energy for cooking;
 - (j) number of rooms;
 - (k) number of bedrooms;
 - (l) type of kitchen;
 - (m) type of bathroom;
 - (n) number of bathrooms;
 - (o) type of toilet facility;
 - (p) whether dwelling is air-conditioned or not;

- (q) telephone service;
- (r) availability of computer in the home;
- (s) number of motor vehicles regularly available for use by the household;
- (t) repairs to dwelling;
- (u) use of dwelling for business purposes;
- (v) type of business (if applicable);
- (w) type of ownership;
- (x) rent paid (if applicable);
- (y) mortgage paid (if applicable); and
- (z) whether household engages in agricultural activity.
